

## Charles Finney on Prayer Meetings

1. Open with Scripture reading appropriate to occasion.
2. Comment on the nature and object of that prayer meeting.
3. Let those who want to pray do so.
4. Let the more mature Christians take the lead.
5. Prayers should be short.
6. Each person should pray for one object.
7. A change in direction of prayer should come from the leadership.
8. There should be no long periods of silence.
9. Prayers must be offered in the warmth of the Spirit.
10. Non-Christians, that are present, should be pressed to repentance.
